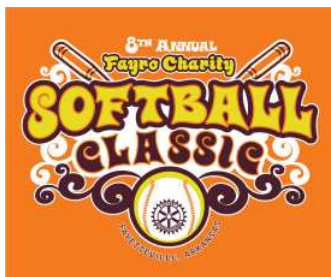
President Howard is now Past President, Mike Gibbs is new Club President. Many thanks to Howard for his service and leadership. Let's all support Mike as he assumes his new position.

than 26,000 children under the age of five die from preventable causes. They never have the chance to dream of a better life. Recently this number has fallen slightly and President Lee says this may well be partly a result of Rotary projects which address problems related to health, hunger, water and literacy. Programs which provide insecticide treated bed netting help prevent malaria. Water well projects provide clean drinking water, and projects like our Thai water tanks project provide water for sanitary purposes. No doubt our Medical Supplies Network District project provides means for medical people to save lives.

Like our Polio Plus project, these sorts of efforts by Rotarians can have an impact around the world. Some will surely allow some kids to dream who would never have had that chance otherwise..
